The Chairman called the Public Hearing to order at approximately 7:00 P. M..

The Chairman asked the Township Planner to explain the proposed Ordinance. The Planner stated that in the existing Property Maintenance Code there is a provision for tall grass and weeds. This proposed Ordinance changes the existing to include much larger lots and making the existing much more comprehensive; will apply to areas of one or more lots per acre in a residential development.

There were no comments offered by any public attendee.

The Board agreed the proposed Ordinance was long overdue. On a motion by Glenn O. Shetter, seconded by Todd E. Burns, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that Township ***Ordinance No. 2009-4*** identified as "*Property Maintenance – Grass and Weeds*" be adopted as presented.
