### BULK COLLECTION DAYS

Fall bulk collection days have been scheduled for Friday and Saturday September 20 & 21, 2002. The collection will be at the Township building located at 1145 Garver Lane in the village of Scotland. The collection will begin Friday at 7:00 AM and will finish at 3:00 PM. The collection will begin Saturday at 6:00 AM and will finish at 4:00 PM. This is a service provided free of charge to the residents of Greene Township from the supervisors. Please inform your neighbors and friends of this service and encourage them to participate.

Please do not bring batteries, liquefied paints, spray cans, propane bottles, fuel drums, and other hazardous materials because we will be unable to accept them. In addition, construction debris will not be accepted. Arrangements will have to be made with the landfill to dump construction debris. We will accept items not picked up by your regular trash service but we do not accept regular household trash. Yard waste will also not be accepted during bulk collection. Greene Township accepts yard waste on a regular basis at our yard waste composting facility on Mickey's Inn Road.

**NOTE THE FOLLOWING CHANGE:** We will accept up to eight tires per household for disposal at bulk collection days this fall. We will only accept tires—No rims allowed.

## Drought Emergency Restrictions

*The following is a summary of restrictions for residential water users from both public and private sources.*

- Use of any water for watering grass except newly seeded or sodded grass areas can be watered during the hours of 5 p.m. to 9 a.m. by means of a bucket, can or hand-held hose equipped with an automatic shut-off.
- Use of fresh water for irrigation and watering of outdoor gardens, landscaped areas, trees, shrubs and other outdoor plants except water applied by means of a hand-held hose equipped with an automatic shut-off nozzle, or an irrigation system designed and operated to restrict the timing or total volume of water and to restrict the application to specific plantings and that ensures effective conservation, when applied between the hours of 5 p.m. and 9 a.m.
- Use of any water for washing paved surfaces, such as streets, roads, sidewalks, driveways, garages, patios, parking areas, tennis courts, decks and patios except water can be used for prewashing in preparation for recoating and sealing a paved surface.
- Use of any water for ornamental purposes, including fountains, artificial waterfalls and reflecting pools except water can be used to perform the primary and necessary aeration function for a pond that supports fish life and water can be used to top off ornamental water gardens or fish ponds to the minimum extent necessary to maintain fish and aquatic life.
- Use of any water for washing or cleaning of mobile equipment, including automobiles, trucks, buses, trailers, carts, wagons, railroad cars, campers and boats except an individual may wash personally owned or leased vehicles with buckets or by hand-held hose equipped with an automatic shutoff nozzle for prerinse and rinse, not to exceed a total of two minutes spray time. Water use is limited to odd street addresses on first and third Saturdays of the month and even or no street addresses on second and fourth Saturdays of the month.
- Filling and topping off swimming pools except if approved by the public water supply system from which the water is withdrawn. If water is obtained from other sources, permission from the owner of the source is required.

## STATUS OF BURNING IN GREENE TOWNSHIP

The burning of solid waste/garbage is prohibited in Greene Township. Open burning may be set for leaf waste and yard waste (except grass), provided that prior notification is given to the Franklin County Communications Center. All such burning is to be controlled and performed under full time adult supervision. No open burning is to occur when the Pennsylvania Bureau of Forestry, Michaux District Forester Office, indicates that conditions are not suitable for burning.
