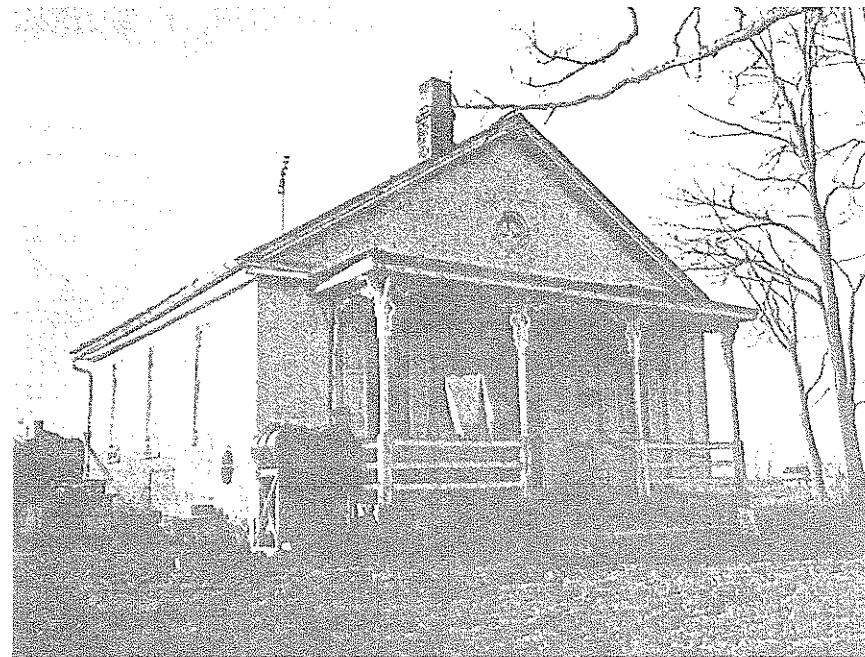


Can You Identify This Picture?

Winter Weather Advisory

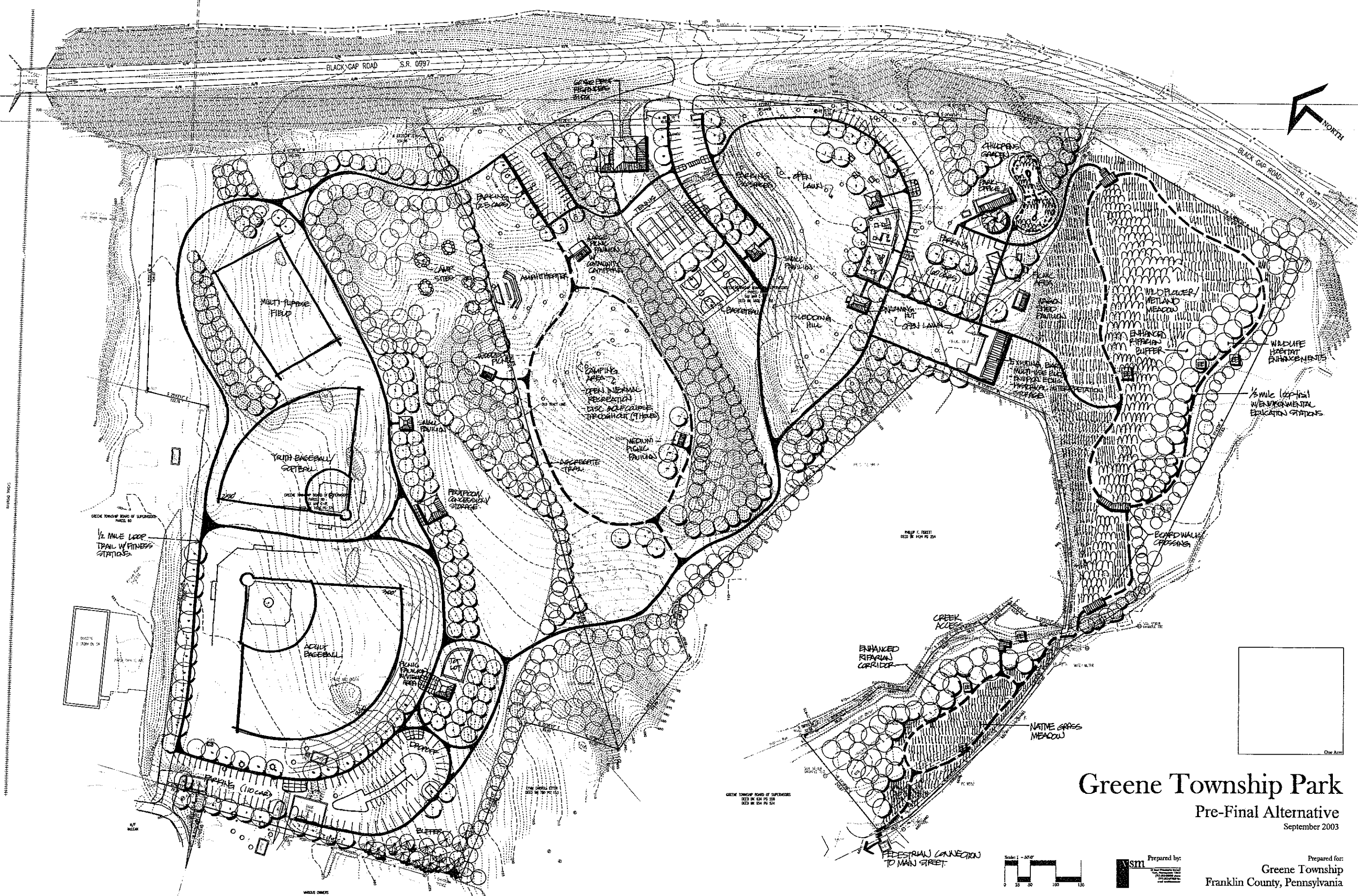
Winter is just around the corner. The Greene Township Board of Supervisors has almost ninety miles of road to maintain. We need your help as we attempt to maintain safe and passable roads this winter. You can assist us by remembering a few important tips:

- Please do not park on township roads and cul-de-sacs. Your car can be damaged from snow and other debris being moved by the plow. This is also a violation of the vehicle code.
- When following a snowplow, please remain a safe distance behind the vehicle so that the operator can see you. These trucks stop and back up often and deposit anti-skid on the road surface.
- Do not shovel snow from your property onto the road surface, or plow across the road to deposit the snow on the other side. These practices reduce the melting effect of the salt and remove the anti-skid from the road surface. This creates an icy patch on the road that is very difficult to remove. This is also against the law and you can be fined up to \$300 per incident.
- If your mailbox is located within the legal right-of-way and it has been damaged in the past, homeowners may want to consider relocating the mailbox. Make sure your mailbox is firmly supported in the ground. Place reflective tape on the mailbox to make it more visible. Remove snow from around the mailbox.

Most importantly, if you don't have to be traveling, please stay home. The lesser number of vehicles on the road the better it is for our operators to do a fast and effective job of removing snow and ice.

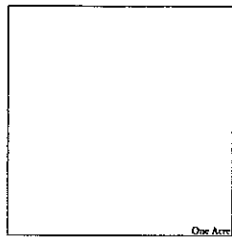

Spring 2004 Bulk Collection Mark Your Calendar Early!

Thank you to all who participated in bulk days this past September. Greene Township collected almost 60 tons of refuse for disposal and almost 45 tons of recyclable metal. In addition, 829 tires were collected.

Bulk Collection days for spring 2004 have been scheduled for Friday and Saturday, April 24 & 25, 2004. The collection will be at the Township building located at 1145 Garver Lane in the village of Scotland. The collection on Friday will begin at 7:00 AM and will finish at 3:00 PM. The collection on Saturday will begin at 6:00 AM and will finish at 4:00 PM. This service is provided free of charge to the residents of Greene Township from the supervisors. Please inform your neighbors and friends of this service and encourage them to participate.

Please do not bring batteries, liquefied paints, spray cans, propane bottles, fuel drums, and other hazardous materials. We are unable to accept them. In addition, construction debris will not be accepted. Arrangements need to be made with the landfill to dump construction debris. We will accept items not picked up by your regular trash service but we do not accept regular household trash. Yard waste is also not accepted during bulk collection. Greene Township accepts yard waste on a regular basis at our composting facility on Mickey's Inn Road.

NOTE: Once again, we will accept tires. We will accept up to eight tires per household for disposal at bulk collection days this fall. We will only accept standard car or pick-up truck tires. No rims are allowed.

Compost Facility Christmas Tree Disposal

The Greene Township yard waste composting facility is open year round to Greene Township residents on Saturdays from 8:00AM until 1:00PM. The facility is closed on holiday weekends, bulk disposal weekends and during major snow events. This schedule will continue for Christmas tree disposal starting January 3rd.

In addition to Christmas trees, the Composting Facility accepts leaves, brush, and tree limbs up to four inches in diameter. We are unable to accept shrubbery with the root ball still attached.

You may call the Greene Township Office at 263-9160 for more information or to make special arrangements if you are unable to make it during our regular hours of operation.

Blue Ridge Landfill Hearing

Greene Township has been notified that the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has scheduled a public hearing for citizens to present testimony and comments on an application for IESI Blue Ridge Landfill to increase the average and maximum daily tonnage to be received at the facility. This hearing will be held on Wednesday, November 5th, 2003 beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the Scotland Community Center, 3832 Main Street, Scotland.

A copy of the application is available for review at the DEP's Southcentral Regional Office at 909 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-8200. Those interested in reviewing the application should contact the file room at (717) 705-4732 to schedule an appointment.

This will be a public hearing. The comments received will be considered by DEP in completing its review and prior to taking final action concerning the application. Questions about the hearing can be directed to Sandra Roderick, DEP Community Relations Coordinator at (717) 705-4703.
