Spring 2012 Bulk Collection

Mark Your Calendar!

Bulk Collection days for Spring 2012 have been scheduled for:

Friday, April 20, 2012 Saturday, April 21, 2012 7:00 AM - 3:00 PM 7:00 AM - 4:00 PM

The collection will be at the Township building located at 1145 Garver Lane in the village of Scotland. This service is provided to the residents (not commercial) of Greene Township from the Supervisors.

Residents should bring drivers license as a form of identification or have a Greene Township identification sticker on the vehicle. A bulky item is an item that will not fit in your garbage container or weighs more than 50 pounds. Bulky items must be free of all garbage. Building materials, loose material, and items that can be broken down to fit in a garbage container are not bulky items and will not be accepted.

Please do not bring liquefied paints, spray cans, fuel drums, and other hazardous materials. We are unable to accept them. In addition, construction debris will NOT be accepted. Arrangements need to be made with the landfill to dump construction debris. We will accept items not picked up by your regular trash service but we do NOT accept regular household trash (bags of garbage, recyclables, etc). Yard waste is also not accepted during bulk collection. Greene Township accepts yard waste on a regular basis at our composting facility on Mickey's Inn Road.

NOTE: Vehicle batteries will be accepted again. We continue to accept 20 lb. propane bottles as well as up to eight tires per household for disposal this Spring. We can only accept standard car or pick-up truck tires. Rims and tires must be separated.

The only burning permitted in Greene Township is, but not limited to, recreational fires, farming operations, and clearing & grubbing for construction purposes only, as per Township Ordinance No. 2004-7.

Spring Brush & Leaf Collection

Greene Township will be commencing **Spring brush** and **leaf pick-up** during the following dates:

Monday, April 9 - Friday, April 20, 2012

The collection crew will make ONE pass through the Township. Please place your brush and rake your leaves to the edge of your yard, no further than 4 feet from the edge of the pavement of the road. Do not bag your leaves. Brush should be no longer than 8 feet in length. The brush and leaves must be on separate piles in order for the Township machinery to collect it and must be placed for pick up on the

first day of the collection schedule. If the brush and leaves are not separated, they will not be collected. Please avoid placing brush and leaves next to mailboxes, fence posts, etc. as they can be damaged by the equipment.





Flood Hazard Mapping

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has revised the Flood Insurance Rate Mapping (FIRM) for all municipalities within Franklin County. The new mapping for Greene Township became effective on January 18, 2012. Copies of the new FIRM are available for viewing at the Greene Township office if you wish to determine if your property has been affected.

Pennsylvania State Police

Every day, American consumers receive offers or claims of winnings and prizes through the mail, by telephone or through email. The **Pennsylvania State Police** would like to inform citizens to be aware of these offers because they could very well be fraud. Fraud is a crime in which you decide on whether to participate. Hanging up the phone or not responding to questionable mailings or emails makes it difficult for the scammer to commit fraud.

Remember, if it looks too good to be true, it probably is.

The website <u>www.consumerfraudreporting.org</u> offers the following list of tips on how to identify a scam or fraud.

- The organization has no website and cannot be located in a web search engine such as Google.
- The email or requestor asks for bank account information, credit card numbers, driver's license numbers, passport numbers, your mother's maiden name, or other personal information.
- The email or caller advises that you have won a prize - but you did not enter any competition run by the prize promoters.
- The email claims you won a lottery (there is no known legal lottery that notifies winners by email).
- The mail may be personally addressed to you but it has been posted using bulk mail - thousands of others around the world may have received the exact same notification.
- The return address is a yahoo, hotmail, gmail, or other free email account.
- The literature contains a lot of hype and exaggerations, but few specific details about costs, your obligations, how it works, etc.
- The prize promoters ask for a fee (for administration, "processing", taxes, etc.) to be paid in advance.
- The scheme offers bait prizes that, if they are real, are often substandard, over-priced, or falsely represented.

Greene Township Park

Composting Facility

The Greene Township yard waste composting facility will continue to be open Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays from 8:00 AM until 1:00 PM. This schedule will continue throughout the year except on holidays, holiday weekends, or special events such as bulk collection days.

If the compost facility will be closed, signs will be posted at the gates.

The composting facility accepts most types of yard waste except grass clippings. All material generated by the composting facility is available only to current township residents (photo identification or Greene Township identification sticker will be required) at a cost of \$5.00 per small bucket scoop and \$10.00 per large bucket scoop. No dump truck loads permitted. At various times during the year, after completing the composting process, leaf compost and bark mulch are available for pick-up. Material is on a first come first served basis. You may stop by the facility on Mickey Inn Road during regular hours to check on availability.

The Greene Township yard waste composting facility is a service provided by the Greene Township Board of Supervisors and is partially funded through recycling grants provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.
