Greene Township will provide dumpsters for residents to unload their bulky items. Residents should expect to unload their own items into the equipment provided. Township personnel may assist residents with their items. A bulky item is an item that will not fit in your garbage container or weighs more than 50 lbs. Construction material will NOT be accepted. We will be accepting up to **8 tires** per household **per day**. **No return visits**.

The collection will be at the Township Complex located at 1145 Garver Lane, Chambersburg, PA 17202 in the village of Scotland. This service is provided to the residents (not commercial business) of Greene Township from the Supervisors.

Brush & Leaf Collection

Greene Township will be commencing brush and leaf collection this fall beginning on the following dates:

Brush: Monday, October 17

Leaves: Monday, November 7

Emergency Medical Services Subscription

Grants Available for Nonprofit Organizations
