The Greene Township Board of Supervisors held a regular meeting on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 at the Greene Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Chambersburg PA 17202.

Present: Todd Burns, Travis Brookens, Shawn Corwell – Supervisors, Kurt Williams – Solicitor, Gregory Lambert – Engineer, Lindsay Loney – Secretary/Treasurer

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, advised that the meeting will be recorded for accuracy purposes and visitors were asked to sign in.

The minutes of the regular meeting held May 23, 2023 shall stand approved as presented and become part of the official record.

The Chairman announced the opening of sealed bids for the 2023 Striping and Marking. Three bids were received, which the Chairman opened and read aloud. Pricing is as follows:

On a motion by Supervisor Brookens, seconded by Supervisor Corwell, and by a vote of 3-0 award to Alpha Space Control with pricing as presented.

No visitors were present for public comment.

The Township Engineer presented a request for bond release from DRB Group for Saddle Ridge. The Engineer has inspected the Stormwater basin and confirmed that it does function properly and does not hold water. The Engineer recommended releasing the full bond amount of \$83,832.11. On a motion by Supervisor Corwell, seconded by Supervisor Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted to approve the bond release for Saddle Ridge in the amount of \$83,832.11.

The Township Engineer presented a request for bond release from DRB Group for Upland Estates. He explained that the initial basin was washed out by a storm and was then redesigned. The funds being held were posted for the conversion to the new basin. The Engineer confirmed that he has inspected the basin and all work is complete; he recommended releasing the full bond amount of \$44,898.70. On a motion by Supervisor Corwell, seconded by Supervisor Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted to approve the bond release for Upland Estates in the amount of \$44,898.70.

The Chairman presented Township Resolution 12-2023 to implement a temporary burn ban for Greene Township. He noted that the weather conditions have been very dry so far this summer and are expected to continue that way. As a result, the County Commissioners asked the Supervisors to issue a temporary burn ban for Greene Township. This would be beyond the Township burn ban and would include recreational fires and fireworks. Supervisor Corwell noted that even though we are getting rain, we are still in a deficit. He pointed out that something like this will be difficult to enforce. Once a burn ban is in place, if the state police receive a call they will send the fire department out and they will call the Supervisors. It will be up to the Township to enforce. The Supervisors discussed whether the burn ban should be for a period of 30 days or 60 days; the Solicitor explained that if it were 60 days, the Board would have the option to lift it sooner at a later meeting. The Board concurred that 60 days was the best option. On a motion by Supervisor Corwell, seconded by Supervisor Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted to adopt Greene Township Resolution 12-2023, implementing a temporary burn ban for Greene Township.

The Solicitor had no comments.

On a motion by Supervisor Corwell, seconded by Supervisor Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted to approve and authorize the payment of invoices as follows: check numbers 31274 through 31307 and eight ACH transactions to be paid from the general fund and check number 2293 to be paid from the electric light fund.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting at 7:33 pm.
