

Effective April 1, 2014

Beginning **April 1, 2014**, Greene Township will be implementing a new procedure for purchasing mulch and compost at our Composting Facility. Residents of Greene Township will be required to obtain a prepaid card called a “**Greene Card**”.

- A Greene Card is available only to current Township residents.
- There are two Greene Cards available. A \$10 card for one use only and a \$50 card which will afford the card holder five uses at the Composting Facility. Each “use” is equivalent to one bucket load of mulch or compost.
- A Greene Card can be obtained by visiting the Greene Township office located at 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, during business hours by presenting a photo identification confirming that you reside within the Township. Payment will be due at the time the card is issued.
- Non-residents are not authorized to use the facility.
- A Greene Card will not be replaced if lost or stolen.
- A Greene Card is not available for sale at the Composting Facility, only at the Township office, and only during business hours. There are no transactions at the Composting Facility.
- Staff will punch each \$50 Greene Card for each use at the facility. Once a card is punched five times it will be destroyed. A \$10 card can be used once and will be collected after its use.
- A Greene Card is not required for drop off. Our facility continues to accept most types of yard waste, except grass clippings.
