ADDITIONAL POLICIES

1. Applicant will be responsible to arrange and pay for back hoe. In addition, applicant will be responsible to dig and prepare percolation test holes.
2. SEO will provide water for percolation testing providing he can drive his truck directly to the actual percolation test site without causing damage to his truck.
3. SEO will require applicant to hire a certified professional soil scientist for all fill site evaluations, and for any situation where the SEO feels one is needed, or required. Applicant will be responsible for paying soil scientist.

Chapter 72.41 states that a sewage enforcement officer has the power and duty to issue, deny and revoke permits, and to **take all other actions** necessary to administer and enforce Section 7 of the Act.

The Department of the Environmental Protection staff strongly encourages the use of soil scientist on any fill site.
