The Greene Township Board of Supervisors met in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, December 18, 2013, at the Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, PA.

The Chairman called the Special Meeting to order at approximately 3:15 P. M..

The purpose of this Special Meeting was to consider a subdivision plan proposed by Franklin County on property they own along Franklin Farm Lane next to the existing nursing home; only a small portion of that property is located in Greene Township near the I-81 interchange with the remaining major portion situated in Guilford Township. The Zoning Officer presented the plan to the Board of Supervisors for their review and consideration. He stated the plan had been staff reviewed on behalf of the Township Planning Commission and recommended approval. He stated that Guilford Township Supervisors had reviewed and placed their signatures dated December 15, 2013. Supervisor Todd Burns stated that all costs incurred by both Welton Fischer, Township Solicitor, and for advertising of this Special Meeting should be forwarded to the County for reimbursement to Greene Township.

Following review and consideration, on a motion by Todd E. Burns, seconded by Travis L. Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that since the preponderance of this project is located in Guilford Township, and we are satisfied that Guilford Township's regulatory provisions adequately protect the public interest, Greene Township agrees to accept Guilford Township as the sole regulatory jurisdiction for this application and that all expenses incurred by Greene Township for the Township Solicitor and advertising will be the responsibility of the County (Commissioners).

There being no further business before the Board regarding this Special Meeting, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 3:20 P.M..
