The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to proceed. The Solicitor stated that this Ordinance provides for the erection of stop signs regulating the flow of traffic on Spring Mist Lane at each end where Spring Mist Lane intersects Summer Breeze Lane; and on Summer Breeze Lane at both points of its intersection with Ragged Edge Road.

On a motion by Travis L. Brookens, seconded by Todd E. Burns, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that Township ***Ordinance No. 2010-12*** be approved as presented for the installation of stop signs in the Greene Valley Estates Development.
