October 22, 2013 Scotland, PA 17254 Public Hearing (1 of 2)

The Greene Township Board of Supervisors held the first of two (2) Public Hearings on Tuesday, October 22, 2013, at the Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, PA. The Public Hearing was held to gain public input regarding a proposed ordinance, identified as Township *Ordinance No. 2013-5*, regarding amendments to the Municipal Code related to "Industrial Discharges".

The Chairman called everyone to order at approximately 7:00 P. M..

The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to proceed. The Solicitor presented a proposed ordinance regarding pretreatment of waste before it goes into the Borough of Chambersburg's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WTP). He stated that from time to time, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency requires revisions to the Borough's handling of waste by giving mandate to the Borough and then the Borough passes on to the Township because of their usage. The Solicitor briefly review the few minor changes/revisions as follows: one aspect is the treatment of waste by adding a new definition entitled, "Best Management Practices"; the other is to revise the introductory paragraph to section entitled, "Prohibited Discharges". The Solicitor noted the Public Hearing was duly advertised as legally required.

There were no comments offered by neither the Board Members nor those present in the audience at this Public Hearing.

On a motion by Todd E. Burns, seconded by Travis L. Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that Township *Ordinance No. 2013-5* regarding "Industrial Waste" be approved as presented.

There being no further business regarding this Public Hearing before the Board, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 7:03 P.M..
