The Greene Township Board of Supervisors held the first of five (5) Public Hearings on Tuesday, July 27, 2010, at the Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, PA. The Chairman called the Public Hearing to order at approximately 7:00 P. M..

The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to proceed. The Solicitor explained that in the past the term ‘building permit’ was referenced throughout the Township Code. He stated that in 2004 the State passed the *Uniform Construction Code* and the term “building permit” is used under that Code, therefore, the Township had to glean through the Code and change the term ‘building permit’ to “*Land Use Permit*”; he further stated that all references in the Township Code will now be identified as ‘Land Use Permit’.

There were no further comments offered by neither the Board nor those in attendance at this Public Hearing regarding this matter.

Following presentation by the Township Solicitor and review by the Board, on a motion by Travis L. Brookens, seconded by Todd E. Burns, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted to adopt Township **Ordinance No. 2010-3** which shall change all current references of ‘building permits’ in the Township Code to ‘Land Use Permit’, as presented.

There being no further business before the Board regarding this Public Hearing, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 7:03 P.M..
