Public Hearing (#4)

The Greene Township Board of Supervisors held the fourth of five (5) Public Hearings on Tuesday, January 10, 2012, at the Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, PA. The fourth Public Hearing was held to gain public input regarding a proposed ordinance for 40 mph speed limit on that portion of Byers Road between Black Gap Road (S.R. 0997) and Pine Stump Road (T-613).

The Chairman called the Public Hearing to order at approximately 7:17 P. M..

The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to present this item. The Solicitor stated that Pennsylvania law provides that on streets that are not posted and do not qualify as “residential” streets, unless otherwise posted, the speed limit is 55 mph. He stated an engineering study of Byers Road from Black Gap Road to Pine Stump Road had been completed and found an appropriate speed limit would be 40 mph on this section of Byers Road.

There were no further comments from either the Board or those in attendance at this Hearing.

Following review and consideration, on a motion by Travis L. Brookens, seconded by Todd E. Burns, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that Township ***Ordinance No. 2012-2*** proposing a speed limit for Byers Road from Black Gap Road to Pine Stump Road be established and posted at 40 mph.

There being no further business before the Board regarding this Public Hearing, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 7:19 P.M..
