The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to present this item. The Solicitor stated this ordinance was for a proposed stop sign on St. Andrews Drive onto Fox Hill Drive. He stated that at this time there is a three-way stop and now would become a four-way stop with the proper signs being posted.

There were no further comments from either the Board or those in attendance at this Hearing.

Following review and consideration, on a motion by Todd E. Burns, seconded by Travis L. Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that Township **Ordinance No. 2012-3** to erect a stop sign on St. Andrews Drive with "4-way" under those signs be approved.
