Public Hearing

The Greene Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing on Tuesday, November 12, 2013, at the Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, PA. The Public Hearing was held to gain public input regarding a proposed ordinance, identified as Township **Ordinance No. 2013-7**, for enforcement of Stop signs on various streets in the Village Greene Development.

The Chairman called the Public Hearing to order at approximately 7:00 P. M..

Before opening the Public Hearing, the Chairman asked if there were students in the audience and if so to please stand, introduce themselves, and what class they were attending for this Meeting. Two (2) students introduced themselves; one attending Shippensburg University (Environmental Land Use Planning) and one attending Chambersburg Senior High School (Civics). The Chairman welcomed the students and informed them that if they had any questions during the Hearing to feel free to ask questions at that time or if they preferred, they may wait until it was over and ask questions afterward.

The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to proceed. The Solicitor stated there were Stop signs that were installed in the Village Greene Development, however, no ordinance could be found to enforce them. Therefore, the Township authorized the Township Solicitor to prepare an ordinance for the enforcement of those Stop signs. He presented a proposed ordinance regarding enforcement of the existing Stop signs in the Village Greene Development and reviewed the various locations of the stop signs.

There were no comments offered by neither the Board Members nor those present in the audience at this Public Hearing.

On a motion by Todd E. Burns, seconded by Travis L. Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted that Township **Ordinance No. 2013-7** regarding Stop signs in the Village Greene Development be approved as presented.

There being no further business regarding this Public Hearing before the Board, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 7:03 P.M..
