The Chairman called the Public Hearing to order at approximately 7:25 P. M.

The Solicitor explained that when the Township adopted the park rules, a section was included that prohibited hunting and the firing or discharge of firearms in the Township Municipal Park. The Pennsylvania Game Commission already has a law prohibiting this and they do not want local laws involved. The Township is removing the language that prohibits the discharge of firearms in the Municipal Park from the original Ordinance. The Solicitor noted that the firing or discharge of firearms in the park is still against the law, but it will be against state law rather than township law.

There were no further comments offered by either those in attendance or by any Board Member.

Following review and consideration, on a motion by Travis L. Brookens, seconded by Todd E. Burns, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted to adopt Township ***Ordinance No. 2013-1***, amendment to Chapter 60 of the Township Park Rules and Regulations as presented.

There being no further business before the Board regarding this Public Hearing, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 7:27 P.M.
