November 27, 2012 Scotland, PA 17254 Public Hearing

The Greene Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing on Tuesday, November 27, 2012, at the Township Municipal Building, 1145 Garver Lane, Scotland, PA. The Public Hearing was held to gain public input regarding vacating a portion of Grand Point Road Extended.

The Chairman called the Public Hearing to order at approximately 7:00 P. M..

The Chairman inquired if there were any students in attendance and if so asked they introduce themselves. There were two (2) students, both from Civics class, attending this Meeting. The Chairman welcomed the students and informed them if they had any questions to feel free to ask during the Meeting or afterwards.

The Chairman asked the Township Solicitor to present the matter before the Board and the reason for this Public Hearing. The Solicitor stated there had been a section of Grand Point Road that had been cut off when Interstate 81 was built that was owned by the Township but had never been developed. The property owners adjacent to this small piece of land expressed interest if the Township wished to vacate this small portion and have it added to their individual properties they would like to do so. Therefore, considering this small piece of land was unusable, the Township entered into an agreement whereby the Township would vacate the portion and control of this small piece of land would revert to the abutting property owners. The Solicitor stated that in order for the changes to be made it was necessary for the Township to adopt an Ordinance to vacate the portion that was never built. Resident Glenn Shetter asked if this was the portion on the west side of Interstate 81 and the Chairman noted it was on the Burkholder side of I-81, the former Brindle property. There were no comments offered by any of the Board Members nor those in attendance at this Public Hearing. Therefore, following review and consideration by the Board, on a motion by Todd E. Burns, seconded by Travis L. Brookens, and by a vote of 3-0, the Board unanimously voted the Township adopt Ordinance No. 2012-9 to vacate a portion of Grand Point Road.

There being no further business for the Board at this Public Hearing, the Chairman adjourned at approximately 7:04 P.M..
