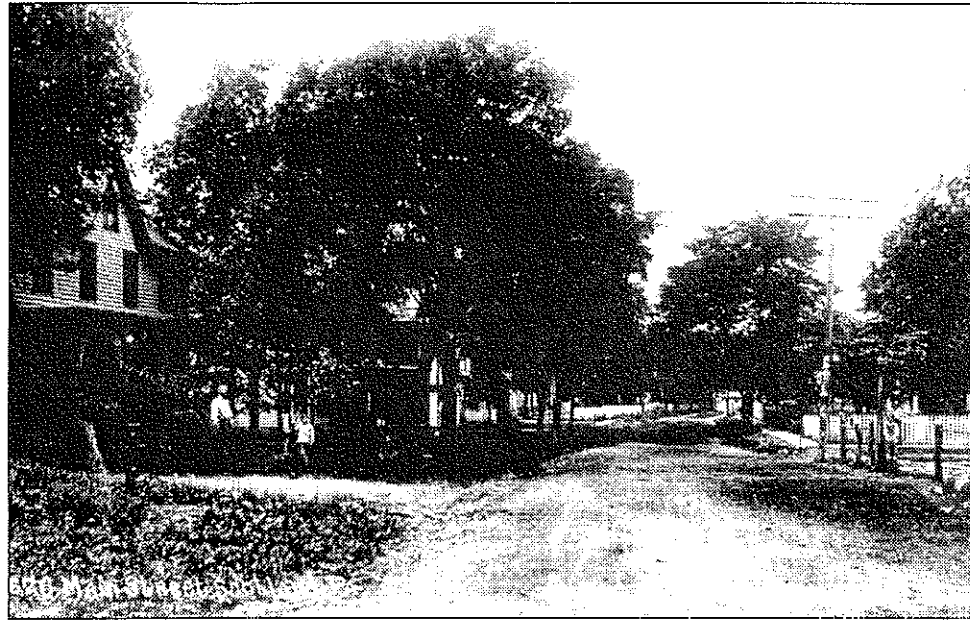


CAN YOU IDENTIFY THIS LOCATION?

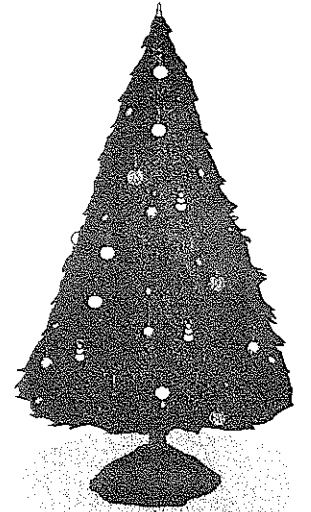
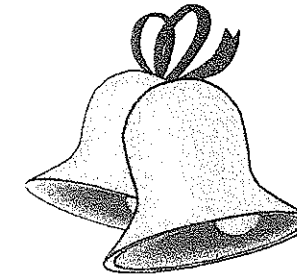
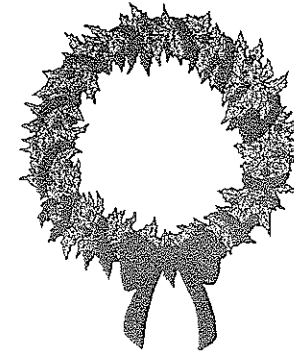

1997 TOWNSHIP ROAD WORK

EACH SPRING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ALONG WITH THE ROAD MASTER TOUR THE TOWNSHIP ROADS TO DETERMINE WHICH ROADS NEED REPAIRED OR REPAVED. THIS YEAR THE TOWNSHIP PAVED AND MILLED APPROXIMATELY 3 MILES OF TOWNSHIP ROADS, INCLUDING THE COMMUTER PARKING LOT AT EXIT 8, AND STRIPED APPROXIMATELY 20 MILES. THE TOTAL COST FOR THIS WORK WAS \$173,177.70: \$152,878.97 WAS PAID FROM LIQUID FUEL MONIES AND THE BALANCE OF \$20,298.73 WAS PAID FROM GENERAL FUNDS.
